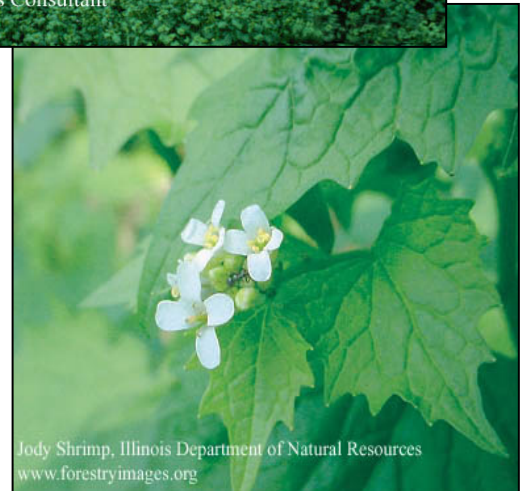


Garlic Mustard (*Alliaria petiolata*)



Highlights:

- Biennial Plant, native to Europe, first found in Canada in 1879
- Grows in a variety of habitats, & thrives in woodlands - prefers some shade with rich, moist soil
- Distinct garlic odour when leaves are crushed
- Flowers early – late April through early May
- Out competes many native plants (considered a threat to the endangered Wood Poppy)
